

Caller ID Telephone Interface

DESCRIPTION

Wireless Caller ID (CID) telephones may be interfaced to Provider® 680 and Pro-Alert™ 640 Nurse Call Systems using the Cat. 6868, allowing them to be used as mobile complements to Nurse Masters for staff to respond to patient calls.

OPERATION

The Caller ID telephone handset rings when a call is received. The room/bed number and type of call is displayed on the CID handset LCD. The call is answered by pressing the TALK button on the handset. If additional calls are received while talking, the Call Waiting tone will chirp. Handset keys are used to invoke additional features including scroll, originate to room, hold, and restore. Note: CID handset initiation of Set Nurse and Aide Service, Send Pocket Page and Origination to Master or other CID Handset is supported on the Provider 680 only.

FEATURES

- Call activity - patient room/bed number and call priority are displayed in full English text on CID handset LCD display
- Two-way voice communication to patient station or pillow speaker
- Receive calls from assigned or all rooms
- Scroll list of calls waiting - answer in any order
- Interfaces with any Caller ID telephone
- Originate call from CID handset to room
- Place call on Hold to answer another call and restore
- Send Pages with "tag messages" to staff on systems with pocket page

- Set Nurse and Aide Service Reminder for rooms
- Capable of placing and receiving PBX calls
- Originate call from CID handset to Master or other CID Handset

EQUIPMENT

Cat. 6868 Interface is used to connect a Jeron Provider 680 or Pro-Alert 640 Audio-Visual Nurse Call System equipped with a Cat. 6864 Master Interface to a customer provided Caller ID telephone equipped with a Visual Call Waiting feature. The Cat. 6868 Interface is furnished with a 24V plug-in AC adapter and is housed in a metal enclosure suitable for shelf mounting. Size (L x W x D): 6 x 5.5 x 1.5 inches. An RJ-11 jack is provided for connection to the CID telephone base unit and an RJ-45 jack and cable are provided for connection to the Cat. 6864 Interface. Cat. 6870 PBX Adapter is required for placing and receiving PBX calls. One Cat. 6868 is required for each CID Telephone.
